PRACTICAL - signposting

- Hosting and promotion of the <u>Wellbeing Support for the Dental Teams</u> resource

EMOTIONAL – wellbeing/ mental health


• Free <u>wellbeing and mental health support</u> through our provider – Health Assured. Includes an online portal with webinars, an app, a 24/7 helpline for advice and access to up to 6 sessions of free counselling.

FINANCIAL – grant funding

• Grants to individuals to help cover general living costs and / or professional expenses. Usually one off (up to three months) but people can reapply. No funding limit but limitations on what we support with.

SOME STATS FROM 2024 SO FAR...

75 applications from 51 new applicants (people apply more than once)





SOME STATS FROM 2024 SO FAR...

- 49% dental student, 48% dentists and 3% dependants
- 44% supported and 43% unsupported (financially) + 13% pending
- Top three reasons for applying in 2024–
 - 1. Hardship at university (39%)
 - 2. Cashflow/ money management (20%)
 - 3. Other(9%)

FINANCE AND FUNDRAISING

We are humbled to continue to be given contributions from LDC's across the country and for your generosity.
